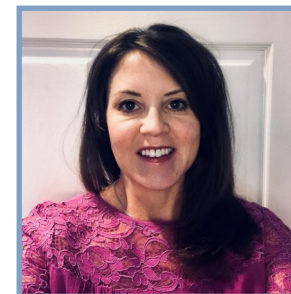
Dorothy Savarese is the chairman, president and chief executive officer of the Cape Cod Five Mutual Company, the sole shareholder of the Cape Cod Five Cents Savings Bank, an independent Massachusetts state-chartered savings bank founded in 1855. The Cape Cod Five has grown to over \$3.2 billion in assets and employs over 500 people throughout Cape Cod, the Islands and Southeastern Massachusetts. Dorothy is chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Cape Cod Five and Chairman of The Cape Cod Five Cents Savings Bank Charitable Foundation Trust, with over \$14 million in assets. Dorothy started as a commercial lending officer at Cape Cod Five in 1993, was named chief operating officer in 2004, and president and chief executive officer in 2005. She is a former chairman of the Massachusetts Bankers Association, a former chairman of the Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, a former secretary and member of the Board of Trustees of Cape Cod Community College and has served on the American Bankers Mutual Insurance Ltd. Board and the FDIC Advisory Committee on Community Banking. Dorothy is the immediate past chairman of the American Bankers Association. In 2017, Dorothy was named one of the 25 Most Powerful Women in Banking by American Banker magazine for the sixth consecutive year. Dorothy holds an MBA from Suffolk University's Sawyer Business School.

Named by *Inc.* as one of the top 100 leadership speakers, **Shelley Row, P.E.**, is an engineer and former government and association executive. Shelley's leadership work focuses on developing insightful leaders who know that data alone is not enough. Her work grows your bottom-line through enhanced decision-making, motivation and teaming. Shelley combines executive experience, results from interviews with more than three dozen executives, and neuroscience to bring this powerful skill to you. Her work was featured in *Forbes*, *Fast Company*, *HuffPost Business* and *Smartblog on Leadership*. She studied with the NeuroLeadership Institute, is certified with the International Coach Federation and Business DNA Behavior, and is the incoming President of the National Speakers Association Washington, DC chapter. The speaker has served as a top keynoter for companies such as Bank of America, Deloitte, Forbes, AT&T, Cisco, UPS and Exxon/Mobil, Stanley Black & Decker, Kraft and many more. Kate is the President of the National Speakers Association in Dallas and serves on the advisory board of the Dallas Network Bar. DNB is millionaire Phil Romano high tech members-only Professional network hub. Kate also went to school in Spain while in college where she developed an addiction to Paella.

Jennifer McKinnon was born in 1979, and every year since then has been a significant accomplishment for her. At birth, Jennifer was diagnosed with Cystic Fibrosis (CF) giving her a life expectancy of only two years. With her and her family's determination in the fight against CF to never give up in finding a cure and to climb forward, Jennifer now age 39, has beaten all odds. Through her philanthropy, *Jennifer's Journey*, she has raised more than \$800,000 for CF research in the Maryland community. She was born and raised in Maryland and is a graduate of Towson University with a degree in Health Care Management.
