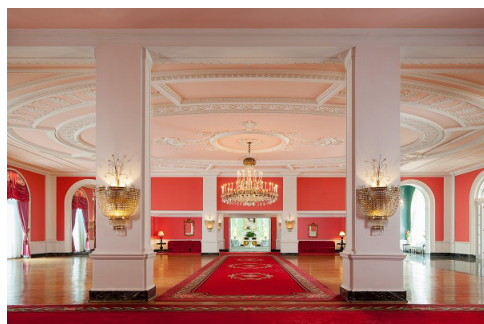

If you've been to The Greenbrier and not taken this tour, you've really missed an incredible experience and glimpse into history. The Bunker (code name: Greek Island) is a former Government Relocation Facility designed during the Cold War to accommodate Congress in the event of nuclear war. This formerly top-secret facility is on hotel property and has been available for tours since it was made public in 1995. No cameras are permitted on this 90-minute tour and the minimum age is 10 years old.

Falconry

The art glass pieces are then secured to a flat square piece of glass using non-toxic glue. The glass is heated in a kiln overnight to create a permanent bond between the various glass elements.
