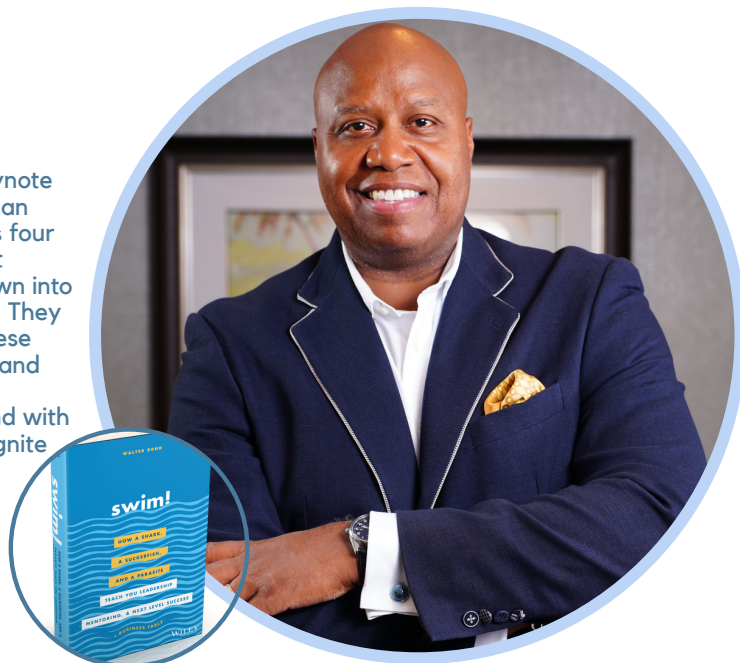
Keynote Session
